TEXAS A&M IFC RECOGNIZED AS RECIPIENT OF 2016 OUTSTANDING PHILANTHROPY AWARD

COLLEGE STATION – Texas A&M University's Interfraternity Council was named the recipient of the 2016 Southeastern Interfraternity Conference Outstanding Philanthropy Award. Out of 65 Interfraternity Councils in the southern part of the nation, only one council was chosen for this award.

The Outstanding Philanthropy Award is given annually by the Southeastern Interfraternity Conference (SEIFC). The award is given to the College Interfraternity Council that best provides initiates and new members with the opportunity to enrich their own lives through charitable giving to the campus or local community in a meaningful way.

In the fall of 2015, the Texas A&M Interfraternity Council launched its first Annual Movember Fundraising Campaign, benefitting the Movember Foundation, a charitable organization aimed at fighting prostate cancer. The Council raised over \$10,000 in a one-month span. Through this endeavor, the Texas A&M Interfraternity Council exhibited the university's core values of excellence and selfless service.
