- Any official activity on the TAMU Campus that involves animals must be compliant with local, state, and federal regulatory requirements, must be attentive to animal and human health, safety and wellbeing, and be held at an approved location.

- Animals must be handled by qualified personnel and be under the direct control of their owners or handlers at all times. The animals must not be left unattended.
- Animals must be provided with adequate shade, shelter, and protection from the elements. As appropriate for the species, animals must have free access to potable water at all times.
- Animals should be in good health and free from conditions that may be contagious to other animals or to humans.
- Animals should be current on all vaccines and tests that are required through best veterinary practices. Examples include vaccination for rabies, freedom from parasites, etc.
- Any animal that is stressed or appears agitated must be removed from the activity. Texas A&M reserves the right to ask for the removal of any animal deemed aggressive or a potential danger to themselves, humans, or other animals.
- Owners/handlers are responsible for cleaning up all animal waste on University grounds and must dispose of the material properly.
- Owners/handlers should be respectful of others and be mindful of the animal's interactions with people and other animals.
- Signing this document verifies I am the owner of the animals and confirms that all of the above conditions will be met. The proctor holds the right to have the animal(s) removed from the premise at any time.
